capabilities in providing suitable facilities and a regular programme of sailing activities to support cadets from ages 8 to 18.

Our ambition is to provide confidence-building, fun and safe sailing opportunities for young people, which includes growing the size of our current cadet group and establishing more events to encourage beginners (non-members) to experience sailing through such initiatives as 'have a go at sailing'. It aims to support young people with all levels of sailing ability, from beginners to advanced, and those aspiring to compete in club-level and inter-club (or higher) racing. TBSC wishes to become a more recognised location on the North Kent coast for young people to learn to sail.



The experience and enjoyment gained from learning to sail can provide many important developmental skills, as well as mental health benefits, for young people.

We would also like to support cadets still in education between ages 16-18 when it typically becomes more challenging to continue with their sailing and membership aspirations.
